

REMINDERS

Clothing

Please help your child/ren by ensuring that as many items as possible are named, especially coats as these frequently get mixed up at break and lunchtimes, causing unnecessary distress to some children. If items are named it helps us reunite them with the correct pupil if they become misplaced or left in the dining room at lunchtime.

Jewellery

Please remember that as part of our uniform policy, pupils should not wear jewellery for school. Wrist watches and stud earrings are permitted, however must be removed for PE lessons.

Make-up

For health and safety reasons pupils should not wear makeup, false nails or eyelashes for school. Pupils who come to school wearing make-up, false lashes or nails will be asked to remove them at the earliest opportunity.

Bikes and Scooters

Pupils must not ride scooters or bikes whilst on the school grounds. This is for safety reasons as the school grounds are very crowded at the start and end of the school day. Refusal to abide by this rule may result in a pupil not being allowed to bring their scooter or bike onto the school grounds. Please be aware that this rule applies to all pupils in all year groups, including pre-school and Nursery.

Mobile phones

For safeguarding reasons, all mobile phones brought into school must be handed in at the school office.
