Nursery Health and Safety Reminder

Could parents and carers please remember to wait outside of the Nursery playground until the door is opened at the start and end of the Nursery sessions. This is so that children are not playing on the equipment at the start of the session and so that they do not get distracted in class by parents/carers waiting to collect them at the end of the session.

Who is eligible for free school meals?

Free school meals are available to pupils in receipt of, or whose parents are in receipt of, one or more of the following benefits:

- **Universal Credit** (provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400, as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods)
 - **Income Support**
 - **Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance**
 - **Income-related Employment and Support Allowance**
 - **Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999**
 - **The guarantee element of Pension Credit**
 - **Child Tax Credit** (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
 - **Working Tax Credit run-on** – paid for four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- If you think you are eligible, please contact the school office in the first instance.

Application is easy and our office staff can help you through the process.

You could save up to £9.50 a week per child - that's over £360 a year.

Our school will also benefit by additional funding which we use to provide additional teachers and support staff (meaning we can have smaller class sizes) and subsidise school visits.

Please apply if you are eligible, even if your child is currently in Reception, Y1 or Y2 and entitled to Universal free School Meals the school will still benefit.
