Packed Lunches –Reminders

If your child brings a yogurt or dessert as part of their packed lunch please include a spoon for them to eat their food with.

Unfortunately a large number of spoons have gone missing from our school dining room as they have been borrowed by children having a packed lunch and not returned – either being taken home or thrown away with packed lunch rubbish.

We encourage healthy eating at lunchtimes and to this end packed lunches should not include sweets or chocolate bars. Fizzy drinks or energy drinks should also not be brought into school as part of a packed lunch.

Pupils who bring a packed lunch are welcome to drink water with their lunch if they do not bring a drink. Drinking water is always available to all pupils in our dining room.

Please be aware that children who bring a packed lunch are encouraged to take any uneaten food home. This prevents waste and also allows parents/carers to keep a track of how much of the lunch is being eaten each day.
