## Important Information for Parents and Carers of Y6 pupils.

It is time to apply for your child's secondary school place.

Children will be bringing home information about this during this week.

**Please be aware that you must apply for a place – your child will not be automatically given a place at any school**

The best way to apply for your child's secondary school place is online using the following website:-

The website opens on September 11<sup>th</sup> and the deadline for submitting applications is **Thursday October 31<sup>st</sup>**. This is during the half term holiday.

Please be aware that if you do not apply by the deadline your chance of getting the school place you want are reduced significantly. If you are unsure what you need to do or how to do it please do not hesitate to contact the school office where one of our administration team will be able to assist you.

Please be aware that whilst Archibald Staff will do all they can to help with your secondary school application – all allocations are made by Middlesbrough Council and as a primary school we have no influence over applications in any way.
